The operators of the Jack London Square Hotel contracted BayCal Painting to perform maintenance painting on this popular waterfront hotel.

The surface of the metal roofs and structural steel railings – a total of 15,000 square feet – were chemical-cleaned and water-washed, then cleaned with PPG PMC's Prep 88 water-based cleaner. One coat of PPG PMC's patented PSX 700 engineered siloxane was then applied. At the eight-month inspection in October, 2004 the PSX topcoat continues to provide outstanding corrosion resistance and long-term color retention.
