This \$10 million ride featured completely redesigned, sleeker trains and introduced all-new, innovative, state-of-the-art visual, audio and sensory effects. Now, with its redesigned 360° rotating seats and head-first, face-down drops along its 3,600-foot maze of steel track at speeds of up to 76 mph, X moved to the fifth dimension and became X² – an extreme ride only Six Flags Theme Parks could deliver!



In the spring of 2008, Six Flags awarded to Baynum Painting of Covington, Kentucky the project of repainting the ride, and PPG PMC high-performance coatings were selected to protect its carbon steel structure, while providing a most attractive appearance. The surface of the ride’s carbon steel structure was prepared and the coating system chosen will provide the ride exceptional protection against corrosion and varying weather conditions:

- One coat of Amerlock 2 fast-drying, surface-tolerant, VOC-compliant epoxy
- A topcoat of PPG’s patented PSX 700 engineered siloxane, which offers breakthrough weather resistance and corrosion control
