Joseph Joslyn is an emerging artist in the Saratoga Springs, New York area. His pieces can be viewed at local galleries and decorate several restaurants in the city, and one of his pieces placed "Best In Show" in July, 2007. He also manages the metal fabrication division of Bonacio Construction Company in Saratoga Springs.

Mr. Joslyn was commissioned to create a one-of-a-kind sculpture for display outside one of Saratoga Springs' premier restaurants. The sculpture – made from new mild steel, machined in patterns to achieve character – required a clear coating that would tolerate and accentuate the character in the steel and retain its gloss, while being able to stand up to the harsh seasonal exposures in the northeastern U.S. for years to come.

PPG sales representatives Brian Myers and Tony Persutti recommended PPG's patented engineered siloxane PSX 700 Clear for the project, which was supplied to Mr. Joslyn through local dealer Allerdice Building Supply. Applied at 7 mils dry film thickness, PSX 700 will provide the sculpture outstanding weather and corrosion resistance.
