The city of Mashantucket, home to the Mashantucket Pequot Tribal Nation, is located in southeastern Connecticut. In the fall of 2007, the Nation’s Foxwoods Casino water tank interior and exterior had deteriorated badly and needed to be repainted. The tank exterior features the Nation’s logo, which offers a reflection of the past: a tree, perched on a rocky knoll and framed against a clear sky, representing the “much wooded land” where people hunted and prospered.

The local PPG sales representative and contractor Service Contracting of Johnston, Rhode Island determined the best high-performance coatings systems for the 6,000 sq.ft. carbon steel tank surface:

- The interior was pit-filled with Nu-Klad 114A epoxy filler compound and then received three coats of Amerlock 2 fast-drying, surface-tolerant, VOC-compliant epoxy.
- The exterior was primed with Amercoat 68HS zinc-rich epoxy primer, followed by a mid-coat of Amercoat 385 multi-purpose epoxy and then topcoated with PSX 700FD, PPG’s patented fast-drying engineered siloxane.

ExTech of Deep River, Connecticut has been consulting with the Mashantucket Pequot Tribal Nation and provided full-time, third-party inspection for the project.
