Six Flags Over Georgia is located on Interstate 20, just west of Atlanta. One of its most popular thrill rides is The Georgia Scorcher, which is 3,000 feet long and stands 107 feet tall at its highest point. It is always “standing room only” on the Scorcher because it has no seats! Thrill-seekers stand at attention as it barrels through a figure-eight, a corkscrew, and two vertical loops – all at speeds of up to 54 mph.

In January of 2006 the park selected Baynum Painting of Covington, Kentucky to repaint the ride, and PPG high-performance coatings were selected to protect its carbon steel structure while providing a most attractive appearance.

The coating system chosen will provide the ride exceptional protection against corrosion and varying weather conditions:

- One coat of Amerlock 2 fast-drying, surface-tolerant, VOC-compliant epoxy
- A topcoat of PPG’s patented PSX 700 engineered siloxane, which offers breakthrough weather resistance and corrosion control
